Amphibian and Reptile Conservation is offering training courses in support of the *Reptile Habitat Management Handbook*

Natural England and Amphibian and Reptile Conservation have provided finances for a series of courses aimed at site managers, advisers, local authority staff and others with an interest in managing habitat to benefit all native UK reptiles.

The half dozen reptile species have experienced population declines and are now all Biodiversity Action Plan priorities. The course will look at habitat management practices and make recommendations as to how they can be applied or modified to benefit reptiles.

The courses will also provide an opportunity to feed back on the handbook.

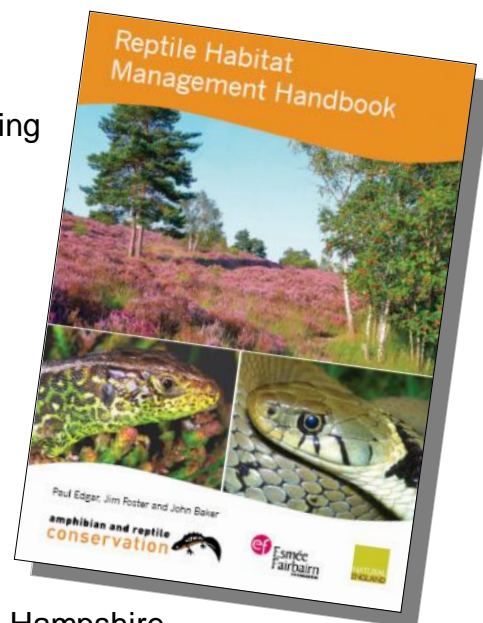
